- Advisory Board: Nothing to report.

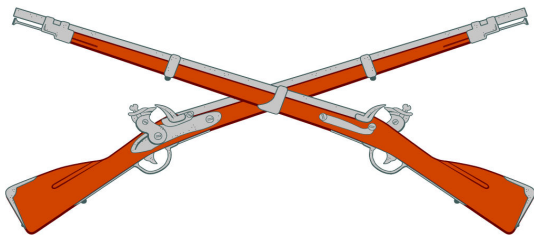
### **Committees:**
