RSC Membership Renewal

The RSC membership renewal is fast approaching. This is the first official notification to all members that the club dues are to be paid from April 1st to April 30th.

Regular/Associate dues are ninety six dollars (\$96) and Senior Regular/Associate dues are forty-eight dollars (\$48). As RSC members, you are also subject to a one hundred dollar (\$100) maintenance fee, if you did not log a minimum of twelve (12) hours on a committee or through work parties during the current membership year. The RSC secretary maintains the official list of hours worked.

Each member will also be required to sign the club official **Waiver and Release of Liability Form**, when renewing their membership. Because this form must be signed in the present of a club officer, renewal of membership through the mail will no longer be accepted.

All dues must be received no later than April 30th. Any member who fails to pay their dues by this date will be dropped from the club membership. Members who fail to meet the above date can resubmit their application and will be placed on the waiting list in the order it was received. FYI, the waiting time to rejoin is very close to two (2) years, if not more.
