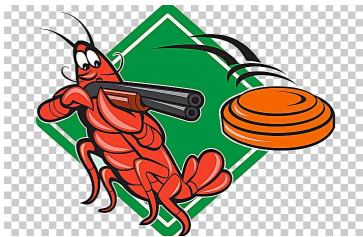


Raymond Town Fair Bingo
