I Understand, that I am only allowed one guest at the range per visit. 8. I Understand, that membership renewal is in April of each year. 9. I Understand, that associate members must complete 25 hours of service to the RSC and be a member for a minimum of one year, to be eligible to advance to regular member status, providing that there are openings available. (ARTICLE V, Section 1.c. 2.) 10. I Understand, that my use of the RSC ranges and participation in club activities are voluntary and represents a possible hazard to myself and guest. RSC Pistol/Rifle Range Rules

** Every RSC club member, who chooses to make use of the club rifle/pistol range, must read this document and comply with all rules listed.

- 1. All ranges are for the use of RSC members, their guest (1), the Spacetown Beagle Club, the Raymond Boy Scouts, the Raymond Police Department and other organizations approved by the RSC members.
- 2. The first club member entering the range area will unlock the gate and leave it open while members and guests are shooting at the ranges.
- 3. The first member arriving at the range must post the red flag, and the flag must remain flying while the range is active. The last member exiting the range will remove the flag.
- 4. All members at the range <u>must sign in the logbook</u> before shooting.
- 5. No parking of any vehicles are permitted on the ranges, except for the range maintenance crew.
- 6. Shooting is permitted only from benches or the front edge of the concrete firing platform.
- 7. Shooting is permitted on club approved targets only, i.e., paper and cardboard.
- 8. All loaded firearms must be pointed down range, without exception.
- 9. If a shooter needs to go down range, he/she must notify everyone at the range of the shooter's intentions.
- 10. Before a shooter is permitted to go down range, all:
 - A. Firearms must be on safe
 - B. Firearms must be cleared of rounds and magazines.
 - C. Chambers must be open.
 - D. Firearms must remain Hands Free.
 - E. Members and guests remaining in shooting bench area must stand behind the red safety line.
- 11. All brass, unfired rounds, trash etc. must be picked up and disposed of in appropriate receptacles.
- 12. NO alcoholic beverages or narcotics of any kind are allowed at the range area.
- 13. The last member exiting the range area must close and lock the gate.
- 14. All NRA sanctioned firearm safety rules must be strictly adhered to by all present.
