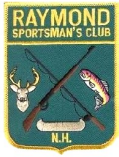

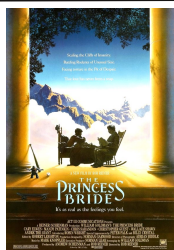

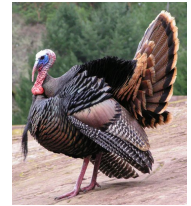
RSC 2024 Game Dinner
