




Raymond Sportsman's Club (RSC) Bingo Event



The 50th annual Raymond Town Fair is quickly approaching. One of the main attractions at the fair is the RSC Bingo Tent. If you have not yet participated in this event, it is a fantastic opportunity to meet and connect with your fellow RSC members. This three-day event is also the only time that RSC has a presence in the Raymond community, so we strive to create a welcoming atmosphere for our patrons.

The bingo event requires a significant amount of manpower, with 300-400 member hours needed to make it a success. The event itself runs for 20 hours, and an additional 4 hours are needed for set-up and take-down. The 7 routes, which involve delivering town fair booklets to businesses in Raymond and neighboring towns, take an average of 6 hours each.

The following positions are available for this event, along with the potential hours that can be logged: Town Fair booklet distribution (5-6 hours), Banker (up to 22 hours). Caller (up to 21 hours.) and Runner/Sales (up to 22 hours.). While no one is required to work the entire duration of the event, many members choose to do so.

This is a great opportunity for members, especially new ones, to earn maintenance hours towards next year's membership renewal. Associate members can also earn the necessary hours to become Regular members at this event.
