All club members are required to adhere to the following obligations.

1. Attend the meetings regarding my membership acceptance.
2. Make every effort to attend all scheduled meetings. The meetings take place on the first and third Wednesday from January to September at 7PM. From October to December, meetings will be held only on the first Wednesday of each month at the same time.
3. Read and honor the club bylaws, range rules, and policies of the RSC.
4. If I lose my club key, I will need to pay the club treasurer a fee of \$10 for a replacement. Should I lose my key again, lend it to a non-member, or create a duplicate, I may face suspension or expulsion from the club, as outlined in the club bylaws.
5. It is advisable for all members to participate in a committee.
6. I am accountable for the actions of any individuals utilizing the club facilities as my guests.
7. I am permitted to bring only one guest to the range during each visit.
8. I acknowledge that membership renewals occur annually in April.
9. To qualify for advancement to regular member status, associate members are required to complete 25 hours of service to the RSC and maintain their membership for at least one year, contingent upon the availability of openings.
10. I acknowledge that my participation in the RSC ranges and club activities is voluntary and may pose risks to both myself and my guests. It is my duty to ensure that my guest accompanying me signs the club's official **Waiver and Release of Liability** form prior to utilizing any club facilities.

All fees and dues will be settled upon acceptance as a member of the club.

RSC Pistol/Rifle Range Rules

All members of the RSC who wish to utilize the club's rifle and pistol range are required to read this document and adhere to the outlined rules.

1. Access to all ranges is reserved for RSC members, their one guest, Spacetown Beagle Club, Raymond Scouting America, the Raymond Police Department, and other organizations that have received approval from RSC members.
2. The first member to arrive at the range will unlock the gate and keep it open while other members and guests are engaged in shooting activities.
3. The initial member to arrive at the range is responsible for raising the red flag, which must remain displayed for the duration of the range's operation. The final member to leave the range will take down the flag.
4. All individuals utilizing the range are required to **sign the logbook** prior to engaging in shooting activities.
5. Parking of vehicles on the ranges is strictly prohibited, with the exception of the range maintenance crew.
6. Shooting is allowed exclusively from the benches or the front edge of the concrete firing platform.
7. Shooting is allowed exclusively on targets that have been approved by the club, specifically paper and cardboard.
8. All firearms that are loaded must be directed downrange at all times, without exception.
9. When a shooter intends to move downrange, it is essential to inform all individuals present at the range of this intention.
10. Before a shooter is permitted to go downrange, all:
 - (a) Firearms must be on safe
 - (b) Firearms must be cleared of rounds and magazines.
 - (c) Chambers must be open.
 - (d) Firearms must remain **hands-free**.
 - (e) Members and guests in the shooting bench area are required to remain behind the designated red safety line.
11. All spent brass, unfired ammunition, and debris must be collected and disposed of in the designated containers.
12. The consumption of alcoholic beverages and any form of narcotics is strictly prohibited in the range area.
13. The last member leaving the range area is responsible for securing the gate.
14. All individuals present are required to strictly follow the firearm safety rules set by the NRA.

Failure to adhere to the RSC Rifle/Pistol Range Rules may lead to disciplinary measures and the possible revocation of club membership.
