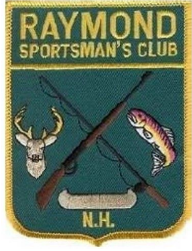

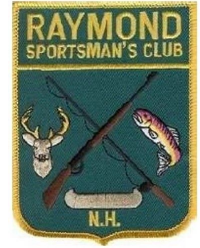

Attention All RSC Members

The issue of leaving the clubhouse doors unlocked has become increasingly problematic among members. On June 22nd, Ed Knowles discovered the front door ajar while he was at the clubhouse to restock applications and welcome packets for new members. Despite clear instructions posted above the inside handle on how to properly secure the door, which involve pressing a button and turning it clockwise, the guidelines are not being followed.

Furthermore, the lock at the end of the clubhouse has suffered damage on two separate occasions due to excessive force applied during unlocking attempts. It is essential to note that unlocking the door requires minimal effort; a simple quarter turn of the key, in either direction, is sufficient to unlock it.

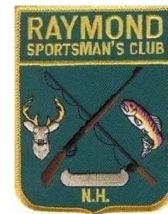
1. To submit your information for the Classified Corner, include both photos and a detailed description of the item you wish to sell or purchase.
