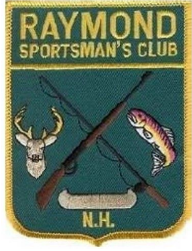

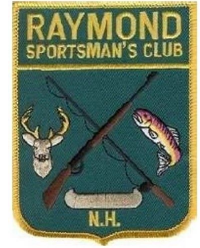

Vandalism of RSC Property

Members who have information about the individual deliberately causing harm by shooting at the legs of the target at the pistol range are urged to report this to an RSC officer. Such actions constitute a violation of the club's Bylaws concerning the destruction of RSC property. All members are familiar with this regulation, as they signed a statement acknowledging it upon joining the club.

When engaging targets on the RSC range, it is essential to ensure that the targets are staggered rather than positioned directly behind one another.



Updated Policy for the Classified Corner

A new policy must be established due to individuals submitting advertisements in the RSC newsletter for buying and selling items without notifying the newsletter chairperson upon the completion of their transactions. The subsequent guidelines will be adhered to and strictly implemented as follow:

1. To submit your information for the Classified Corner, include both photos and a detailed description of the item you wish to sell or purchase.
2. Once you have finalized your sale or purchase, inform the newsletter committee.
3. The advertisement will stay in the Classified Corner until it is either removed by the individual selling or seeking items or until one year has passed from the initial publication date in the newsletter.



Precision Rifle Series (PRS)

The PRS represents a premier long-range precision rifle shooting sport and serves as the foremost organization for competitive precision rifle events globally. PRS manages competitions at local, regional, national, and international levels, offering a well-defined structure for matches along with a comprehensive system for score tracking and ranking. Competitors face real-world shooting scenarios, engaging steel targets from diverse positions such as barricades, rooftops, prone stances, and natural landscapes. The primary goal is straightforward: to strike as many targets as possible within a designated time frame. Each match tests a shooter's capacity to merge accuracy, movement, and strategic decision-making under pressure.

On July 5th, RSC member Mike Fall competed among 41 shooters, securing an impressive 4th place finish. The competition featured shooting distances of up to 734 yards, and Mike utilized a Ruger Creedmoor 6.5 rifle for his performance.
